BOAT CHECK:	STARTING AT 7:00 AM
START:	8:00 AM WILL START BY POSITION AN ANNOUNCED BY THE STARTER
WEIGH-IN:	5:00 PM - MUST BE BACK BEFORE 5:00PM FOR CHECK-IN
CASH PAYBACK:	80% OF THE FIELD ENTERED
ENTRY FEE:	\$125 PER BOAT - PAY CASH AT CHECK-IN TIME AT THE RAMP BEFORE START
PAYOUTS:	PAYOUT 1ST, 2ND, 3RD PLACE AND BIG BASS
OFF LIMITS:	NO FISHING INSIDE THE BREAK WALL AND NORTH END PAST THE BUOYS!
FORNAT:	BEST 5 FISH TO THE SCALE, 1LB FOR DEAD FISH AND HALF POUND FOR SHORT FISH!

Rules

1. There is a 50 boat limit for this Open Tournament.
2. All participants will meet for CHECK-IN and SIGN UP at 06:00 AM at STATE PARK BOAT RAMP.
3. **ALL BOATS MUST RETURN BY 03:00 PM TO THE STATE PARK RAMP FOR THE FINAL WEIGH-IN. ANYONE THAT IS LATE WITHOUT A CALL TO A TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FOR THAT WEIGH-IN PERIOD.**

5. All State and local laws will be respected, observed, obeyed and enforced
6. No alcohol or controlled substance can be used or allowed in the boat during the tournament hours.
7. **No Practice 24 hours before an event! - This means no lake access at all!**
8. Take off may be delayed or cancelled due to unsafe conditions as determined by the tournament directors.
9. Anglers must be courtesy to other anglers and cannot be any closer than 100ft of another boat!
10. **OFF LIMIT AREA** is the State Park Boat Ramp Area inside the break wall.
11. The outboard kill switch must be used any time the boats big motor is running at above an idle
12. Only artificial lures are acceptable! **No Live Bait is Permitted!!**
13. All boats must be equipped with a working LiveWell. Fish care is number **One Priority!**
14. **WEIGH-IN:** MAXIMUM BAG of 5 FISH with a MINIMUM LENGHT of 12 inches. Short fish will result in a half (½) pound penalty plus the loss of the fish. The dead fish penalty will be one (1) pound penalty per fish. No more than five (5) fish are allowed in live well (in possession) at any time, 6th fish must be culled before returning to fishing. Anyone bringing more than five (5) fish to the weigh-in scale will not be allowed to weigh in ANY fish and Disqualified.
15. The Weigh-in Officials will **NOT** weigh more than one fish for BIG BASS
16. **No Practice 24 hours before an event! - This means no lake access at all! -THIS IS AN AUTOMATIC DQ!**
17. **PROTEST:** All protests must be submitted in writing to a tournament director within five (5) minutes of the weigh-in completion.
